

Guidelines for Groveport Madison Adopt-A-Family (GMAAF)

Each child receiving Christmas from GMAAF “Angels” will receive:

- Coat, gloves, hat (new or gently used, clean and in working order)
- Pajamas, socks, underwear (must be new)
- Toys
 - Newborn-12 yrs old: 2 toys (suggested price \$20)
 - Ages 13-17: gift cards (suggested price \$25)
 - PLUS, each family *may* receive an extra bag of toys from the Madison Fire Dept.

It is intended too for each family to also receive a box of pantry items to help with feeding the children while they are home on winter break. A grocery gift card is also helpful to fill in with perishable items.

Operation:

Select a “liaison angel” to be the coordinator and contact person.

Responsibilities of the liaison angel are:

- 1) Contact Go Groveport for family information.
- 2) Accumulate the list of requested “wish” list items in one of the following ways:
 - a) Divide up the list of items for participating “angels” to select what they want to provide.
 - b) Collect money. Liaison angel will use money to purchase items not fulfilled.
 - c) Combination of one of the above.
- 3) Collection of items from participating angels (set deadline date)
- 4) Secure ID tag for each child to item/package.
- 5) DO NOT WRAP! The parents/guardians will have the option of wrapping at the distribution location OR take wrapping paper home with them to wrap at their convenience. Donations of wrapping paper and tape are always received.
- 6) Food items can be placed in separate cardboard box with family ID number clearly marked on the outside of the box
- 7) Deliver packages to GMFAA at Groveport Zion Lutheran Church, 6014 Groveport Rd (across from Kroger), **on Friday, December 14, 9:00a-3:00p or Saturday, December 15, 9:00a-noon.**
